Work during the coming two weeks will focus on completing footing and foundation excavation and placing rebar in the foundation. Concrete will be poured and steel delivery is scheduled for Nov. 11.

#### CAMPAIGN UPDATE

The continuation of the Pride in Our Past, Building Our Future campaign took another jump during the past two weeks, and now stands at \$2,371,260. The campaign total includes initial gifts of \$1.85 million and \$521,260 from 136 additional donors since the campaign continuation went public. Just \$578,740 is needed in gifts and pledges to fund the remainder of the Phase 1 projects.
